- Expand number, range and quality of local eating establishments (both franchise and local start-ups).
- Expand local shopping and services so most needs can be met locally.
- Implement a Buy Local campaign through the Chamber of Commerce.
- Encourage local preference incentives for institutional buying.



Live Healthy

- Expand local recreational venues and opportunities for local families, both indoor and outdoor.
- Plan and promote community events that get residents and families "Out and Active."

Keep Connected

- Implement universal access to high-speed internet, for use by individuals, families, businesses, institutions and visitors.
- Uplift the sense of community by expanding use of social media to help people and groups to communicate and work together.

A Place of Beauty and Attraction

- Reduce visually clashing cityscapes.
- Develop Aztec initiatives for keeping our community Clean and Green.
- Commit to high levels of stewardship of the natural and built environment.

Rivers, Mesas and Vistas

- Expand well-organized recreational opportunities along the river.
- Attract and promote outfitter, river run and other outdoor action businesses and programs for locals and tourists.



Connect with Nature

- Complete, promote and manage trail connections with river and ruins.
- Expand and develop trails with universal public accessibility.
- Accelerate development and promote utilization of Riverside Park.

 Incorporate the region's outstanding geographic treasures into school curricula, including experiential and

expeditionary learning acti∨ities.



Take Care of Our Town

- Develop a plan of fiscal responsibility to maintain, renew and invest in new infrastructure.
- Implement and enforce code changes, and incentivize community-wide action, to eliminate eyesores and promote aesthetic community design.
- Commit to long-term beautification in architecture and landscaping, including thematic design to magnetize tourism.



Value #4: Strong and Growing

Balanced Growth

- Diversify local economic drivers and assets.
- Ensure and promote good planning, aesthetic design and coordinated development.
- "Go Green": Become a model for small town energy and water efficiency, community recycling and sustainable land use.

Build Up Local Retail

- Conduct community-wide retail demand survey and prioritize local retail development based on results.
- Diversify local retail options for grocery and department store shopping, hardware and home improvement supplies, restaurant dining (both fast food and range of sit-down dining), and entertainment.
- Support and promote locallyowned startups and expansions.
- Develop or bring in high-quality lodging establishments.

Sustain and Optimize

- Maintain our resource development asset and support innovative response to new market opportunities for natural gas utilization.
- Proactively create and provide housing and service opportunities to attract long-term residency by workers in the industry.

Vibrant, Iconic Downtown

- Finish North Main and Arterial developments as building blocks for a revitalized Main Street.
- Design and implement a campaign to diversify, upgrade and expand businesses on Main Avenue, including higher-end retail.
- Energize downtown with new and complementary restaurants, events, gathering places and high -use shops, to include safe, attractive and accessible nightlife.
- Establish a public-private investment entity for planned and responsive downtown investment.

1st Class Education

- Commit resources and community-wide support to providing excellent education for all ages – including alternative and online opportunities.
- "Live here/Touch the World": Bring world-class instruction and information in, and make it accessible to all.

Value #5: Gateway to Fun

Promote the City

- Design and implement a coordinated and robust Aztec promotional campaign for business, industry and tourism.
- Diversify local business mix by attracting new startups and expansions in non-industrial sectors.
- Create a package of benefits, incentives, services and opportunities that will attract, accommodate and retain new companies and residents.



Hospitality "Second to None"

- Create and implement master plan to establish Aztec as a model of hospitality, customer service and accommodations for guests.
- Provide education, training and encouragement of all citizens, beginning with young children, to earn the brand of "friendliest town in the West."



Destination and Launchpad to Adventure

- Design and build a community center to accommodate both residents and tourists/guests, to include recreational attractions.
- Create a "destination" vision, quality and action strategy that includes lodging, retail and entertainment options for visitors.
- Link people's stay "in beautiful small-town Aztec" with area features and attractions.
- Provide business and services that make it easy for guests to "get out in it."



Value #6: History & Hope Unite


Four Corners Trail of the Ancients

- Actively participate in and help lead development of the Trail of the Ancients Scenic Byway and Four Corners Geotourism Initiative.
- Assist in linking regional tourism marketing with Aztec Ruins and other historic attractions in the area.
- Establish a center for research and exploration of the ancient sites and other geotourism resources of the region.



Preserve and Enhance Historic Downtown

- Integrate historic preservation and architectural themes into a "new historic Main Street" for the 21st century.
- Provide a mix of public and private spaces in the downtown to promote full use by locals, while attracting guests into the downtown energy.



We Love our Kids: Education for the Future

- Fully integrate regional historic, cultural and geographic resources into all education and training curricula offered in the schools and for all age groups.
- "Live here/Touch the World": tap community-wide high-capacity internet to bring world-class instruction and information in, and make it accessible to all.

New Infrastrure: Planned and Managed

- Build the "walkable community," safe, beautiful, compelling and accommodating for all residents and visitors; integrate downtown with riverside and urban trail systems; integrate bike and pedestrian utilization.
- Design and develop overall traffic system to minimize congestion, improve flow and connectivity, and ensure public safety.
- Expand transportation options for residents and visitors to increase mobility and convenience, and to reduce vehicular traffic throughout town.
- Commit to universal broadband access, and stay at the cutting edge of internet connectivity for residents and businesses.

Sustain Our Assets: Maintained & Up-To-Date

- Build and maintain for sustainability; maintain momentum on efficient energy and water use and environmentally-friendly infrastructure.
- Strengthen and enforce city code, development rules and investment policies to protect and sustain infrastructure.
- Work to keep the cost of utilities affordable to residential and commercial customers and continually seek short- and longrange efficiencies.

Diverse and Sustainable Housing

- Expand housing options for all income ranges, and consult and collaborate with builders to carry out coordinated, aesthetic, efficient and sustainable housing development.
- Increase residential options in the Main Street/town core to populate & energize the heart of Aztec.
- Make energy-efficient building a community-wide priority, including a range of housing developments.
